Charles and Emma Hensel Kellner Memorial Scholarship

In the late 1800's Charles and Emma Hensel Kellner homesteaded on the north end of Little Sand Lake. They started out in a one room house and eventually built one of the first resorts in this area, known as Shady Knoll.

The money for this scholarship was donated by Mary Kellner Baldwin, the oldest of seven children of Charles and Emma Kellner. Mary attended country school for seven years in the building which is now known as the Mantrap Town Hall. She then transferred to the Nevis High School. In 1917 she was one of the five students in the first graduation class from Nevis, a fact she was very proud of. Throughout her 36 years of traveling around the world, she always talked with pride about her education from the small school in Nevis, Minnesota. She fondly recalled her education from Nevis High School as and I quote "equal to or better than a college education."

Eligibility Requirement

1. Be a student enrolled in the Nevis School District for a minimum of four years.
2. Must have maintained average or above average academic performance during high school.
3. Must be accepted and currently enrolled at an accredited technical, community, four year college or university at the time of the award.

Application Requirements

1. Submit an application portfolio addressing the following information:
 - Cover Page and brief Cover Letter
 - Completed application
 - Activities, Hobbies, and Interests page
 - Separate page explaining future education and career plans
2. Application deadline: April 1 of each year.

Scholarship Award

Scholarship will be awarded upon proof of payment of second semester of third quarter tuition during students second year at an accredited technical, community, four year college or university.
