

Hubbard County Mounted Sheriff's Posse Scholarship

Greetings Counselors and potential applicants

The Hubbard County Mounted Sheriff's Posse is pleased to announce our 2024 scholarship program. A grant of \$750 will be awarded to one graduating senior. We require that the applicant must reside in Hubbard County, although they may attend a school outside of the county. Applicants must be planning to pursue a career in criminal justice. We require that the applicant will be working toward a law enforcement position. Post-secondary training for legal secretary, paralegal positions, lawyer, etc. are not eligible for this grant. Our objective is to support active law enforcement positions.

NOTE: This grant will be paid out upon the successful completion of the first semester or quarter of the candidates second year. The successful candidate must still be in a criminal justice program and have an accumulated grade point average of at least 2.0 to remain eligible. Application forms are available through your school career counselor.

Applications must be received by May 1, 2024 for the grant to be considered.
