ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Must be a resident of the United States.
- 2. Must be a graduate of Nevis High School and must have attended Nevis High School for the 10th through 12th grades.

(Exception: Less than 10th through 12th grade attendance, if a student's parents/parent or guardian is an established business owner or has established permanent residence within the boundaries of ISD #308 District.)

- 3. Must have maintained a 2.0 GPA or better during high school.
- 4. Must be eligible to enter college or technical school by the fall term following selection or be currently enrolled as a freshmen in college at the time of the award.
